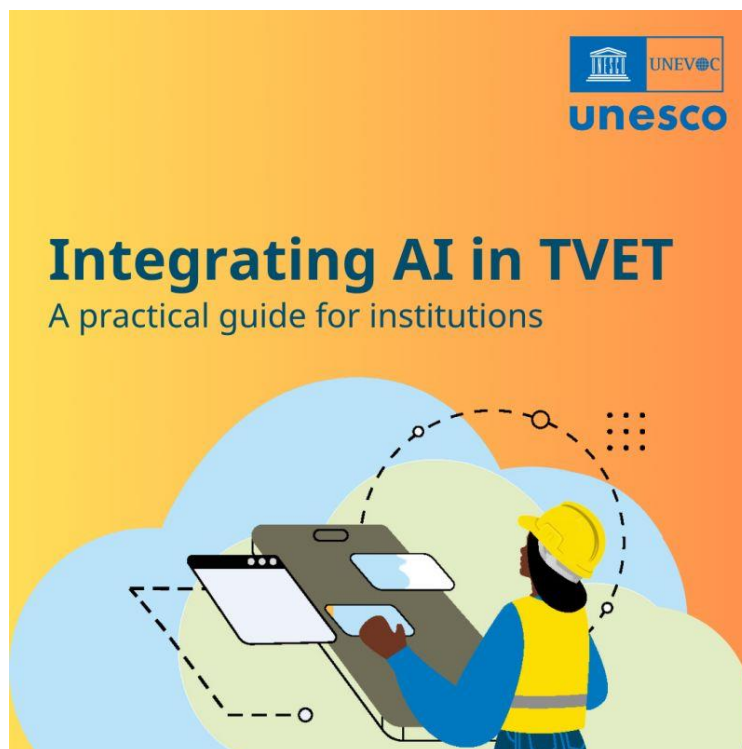

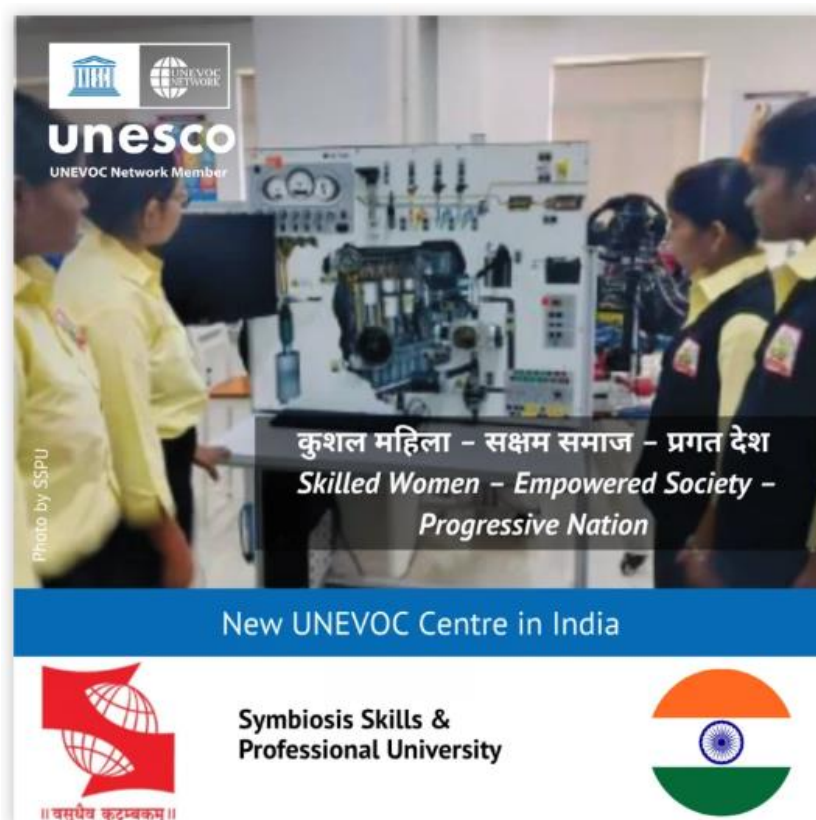


Digital Learning Week 2026. Education in the age of AI: Facts | Frictions | Frontiers
